Am I eligible to join SHRM as a student member?

You are eligible for student membership provided that:

- You are a college student taking the equivalent of at least six (6) credit hours per term in a degree-seeking program.
- Your coursework, taken or planned, supports a demonstrated interest in the field of human resource management.
- Students who are in established, professional roles will retain their current SHRM membership status. Existing professional members will not be eligible to downgrade to student membership.
- Student membership is limited to a maximum of six years, nonconsecutive.

What is the difference between student and professional membership?

Professional membership is designed to meet the needs of people currently working in the HR field, while student membership is designed for individuals just exploring human resources and preparing to enter the profession. If you plan to use the membership to assist in your work as an HR practitioner, we recommend that you join as a regular (professional/associate) member to gain full access to all services and benefits.

Can membership in SHRM help me find a job after graduation?

Application procedure

- Complete the student membership application in its entirety. Special attention should be given to all fields which are designated "required."
- If you are joining a student chapter on campus, please have your advisor sign your application.
- Don't forget to include payment for your membership.
- Mail or fax your membership application to the address listed on the application.
- Please allow 4–6 weeks for processing of mailed applications that include payment by check or money order. If faxing your application with credit card payment, processing time will be substantially decreased.
